President's Report

## Steve Sez

Sometime over the weekend of the ARRL DX CW contest, one of the users on the N6ST node logged off. That is not unusual by itself, but something unfortunate happened. The user's transmitter stayed on the air with an unmodulated carrier. I don't know exactly what failed: the TNC, the cable or the radio. Because the carrier was unmodulated, the TNC at N6ST did not recognize the signal as being there. This turned out to be both good news and bad news.

When I checked on the node on Sunday night I was surprised at the unusually small number of users but did not suspect something was truly amiss. After a call from AB6EQ on the answering machine, I restarted the PacketCluster software to be sure all was OK there. At that time I happened to notice the receive signal strength indicator on the transceiver was showing almost (but not quite) full scale all the time. Anyone with a signal stronger than that was getting in with no problem (about 5 users). Anyone else was out in the cold.

With some help from folks on the DX Club repeater, I determined the signal was originating from someplace in Santa Clara Valley, probably near Saratoga. As we left the mountain on Monday I took my trusty old HT with me. Until I got to Cupertino the signal from the interfering signal was weak with lots of picket fencing. As I approached downtown Cupertino the signal became very strong and I removed the rubber ducky from the HT. Nothing. A couple of blocks later I started hearing the signal with no antenna on the HT. I knew I was close to the transmitter. Unfortunately we had several activities scheduled that precluded an intensive DF effort at that time.

Later in the evening I was able to again chase the signal. Still with the rubber ducky removed, I drove around a neighborhood (Prez. con;t Page 2, col 1)

We sent in roughly 104M for 1993, points garnered by guys getting respectable scores (along with a few lollapaloozas in 1992 like WN4KKN/6's 15-meter SSB USA record of 4.5M from W6QHS's QTH, and N6KT's world high M/S SSB score of 32.5M from HC8A).

- West Coasters can do well, unlike the DX contests.
- Everyone works everyone, so there's a great feeling of camaraderie and egalitarianism absent in most other contests.
- There's lots of activity, and no substitute if you are a prefix hunter, as lots of weird new prefixes show up each year.
- You can turn off packet for the weekend (if you use packet in WPX, you're Multi-single)
- If you're into Windows computer logging, you can use my Windows WPX software (just ask DOS version also)

Correction from 1992 CQP-WA6FIT should have been listed in 6th place for County Expeditions with a combined score of 30,648. Ron's Mono County entry was a County Expedition.

In spite of poor high band conditions the number of entries was up slightly over 1992 but only a total of 3 Novice/Tech logs were received. Average top twenty scores were down 17 % CA and up 2 % Non-CA.

What do the big CA guns run? The top 3 Single Op entries listed a total of 62 elements of aluminium plus numerous wires!

Two CA entries managed new county records (KD6MYG (15 years young) operating KM6OH from Alpine and N6YKL from Yolo. JH7WKO, VE7NTT, AA5ZT, K0PP/7, N1CC/2, N8LXS, LU6EF, WT9B, K4LTA, WA4PGM, and K7OD managed new Non-CA section records.

In the "Sweep" department - 17 Non-CA stations managed to find all 58 California counties and 20 CA stations found all US and Canadian sections.
