AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM KEN, KGHNZ

SUPPORT NCDXC IN ARRL DX says the headline above. This is in return for the SUPPORT AND COOPERATION THAT NCCC RECEIVED FROM NCDXC IN OUR RECORD BREAKING CQ WW DX Contest effort last October and November. All dual members submitted THEIR SCORES FOR NCCC AND A NUMBER OF DX'ERS JOINED OUR CLUB TO ADD THEIR SCORES TO THE CLUB TOTAL. THE NCDXC 2 METER REPEATER WAS USED VERY SUCCESSFULLY AS THE SPOTTING NET. IT IS CERTAIN THAT THE SUPPORT OF NCDXC WAS WORTH MANY MILLION POINTS TO NCCC.

So NOW IN THE ARRL DX CONTEST IT IS OUR TURN TO THROW OUR FULL SUPPORT TO NCDXC. ALL DUAL MEMBERS ARE URGED TO SUBMIT THEIR SCORES FOR NCDXC. REMEMBER THAT NCCC WILL NOT BE SUBMITTING A CLUB ENTRY. HOW ELSE CAN NCCC MEMBERS HELP? The 2/3 rule allows the total score of Multi-Single and Multi-Multi stations TO GO TO A CLUB IF 2/3 OF THE OPERATORS ARE CLUB MEMBERS. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO PARTICIPATE IN A MULTI OPERATOR EFFORT AND WISH HELP TO FIND A SUITABLE STATION, PLEASE CALL ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AT 415)948-2818. REMEMBER, TIME IS short. The CW dates are February 20 and 21 and the SSB dates are March 6 and 7. MULTI-SINGLE AND MULTI-MULTI OPERATIONS ARE A LOT OF FUN AND CERTAINLY THE EASY WAY TO RUN UP A GOOD SCORE.

Another way for NCCC members to assist is to take the 2 meter net control DUTIES, FREEING NCDXC MEMBERS TO WORK THE CONTEST. PLEASE CALL ME IF YOU CAN TAKE ANY NET CONTROL DUTY EITHER WEEKEND.


NOW FROM RICH, VP/CC




