There are several points of view on this subject, two of which are expressed elsewhere in this JUG. What is needed to decide this most crucial question is the will of the membership, from the biggest GUN to the smallest PISTOL.

The purpose for which the NCCC was organized is to encourage participation in Amateur Radio Contests of interest to the members; and to compete as a club in major contest activities. The record of the club in achieving these objectives has been outstanding. Let's continue this record of success. The first step is to determine the interests of the members. To this end a questionnaire regarding contest preferences and other matters is included with this JUG. Please fill in and return promptly. Your completed questionnaire mailed before July 15 qualifies you for the drawing for the \$25 Super Jackpot Prize.

As I see it, the situation is as follows. We are committed to support our own sponsored contest, the CQP. Because of the conflicting dates we can manage a major club effort in either the SS or the CQWW. While the CQWW is a ontest for those of us who like to chase DX (and JA's) it is not in the cards for us to win it against the East Coast DXpeditions. ARRL BULLETIN NR 56 FROM ARRL HEADQUARTERS
NEWINGTON CT MAY 23, 1980 TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS BT

AMSAT OSCAR Phase III was launched at 1429 UTC on 23 May 1980 aboard a European Space Agency Ariane launch from French Guiana. Initial reports are that immediately after launch, one of four rocket engines suffered reduced thrust. At launch plus 1 minute the guidance system could no longer compensate for the tendency to veer off course and the entire launch vehicle entered a wild tumbling spin. At two minutes after launch ground control began losing telemetry and the Range Safety Officer destroyed the vehicle and with it, Phase III.
