
WITH THE SS BEHIND US, IT'S TIME TO START LOOKING AHEAD TO THE 1981 ARRL DX CONTEST. THIS YEAR, IN ORDER TO BOOST THE CLUB'S AGGREGATE SCORE, WE WILL BE USING "INTRA-CLUB" TEAM COMPETITION. THIS IS HOW IT WILL WORK: THE CLUB WILL BE DIVIDED, AT RANDOM, INTO THREE OR FOUR TEAMS OF EQUAL SIZE. EVERY CLUB MEMBER WILL BE PLACED ON A TEAM. EACH TEAM WILL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COVERING EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES WITH AS MANY STATIONS AS POSSIBLE: UNLIMITED MULTI/MULTI; 2 MAN MULTI/MULTI; MULTI/SINGLE; SINGLE-OP, ALL BAND; SINGLE-BAND 160 THROUGH 10; SINGLE-OP LOW POWER. POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE FINISHERS IN EACH CATEGORY, AND THE TEAM WITH THE MOST POINTS WINS THE COMPETITION. 




